## **Conditions of Entry**

Entries open July and close August 1st at 5pm

- 1. Entry is open to current financial members of any recognised NZ art society.
- 2. All work must be for sale, original and the sole work of the exhibitor. Not copied and not done in a class of instruction. Works must **not** have been exhibited in a show previously and must have been completed in the previous 12 months. Works must not breach any copyright laws. Artists agree to all art work becoming available for SCAS to use in advertising or promotional activities now and in the future.
- 3. Entry fee is **non refundable** \$20 per artwork.
- 4. An artist can submit up to 2 entries.
- 5. While every care is taken, SCAS or its members, accepts no liability for any loss or damage All insurance in transit and in situ at the gallery will be the sole responsibility of the artist.
- 6. Digital images of all entries must be forwarded via the online entry form. Photographs should be taken prior t glass framing.
- 7. String is not needed, as the gallery uses D rings to attach to the wall. Please ensure D rings are pointing upwa this is a request from the gallery. No D rings no entry
- 8. 2D works must be suitably mounted for exhibition. **Maximum 1.2m x 1.2m** including frame. NO wet work accepted. Each artwork must be clearly identified on the back with the name of the artist, address, title, medium and price.
- 9. All work is subject to selection the decision of the selection panel is final and no correspondence will be entered into. Artists will be notified where works have not been selected.
- Receiving Days for Out-of-Town Artists: Send works to South Canterbury Arts Society, c/o Helen Willcock, 113 Domain Ave, Timaru 7910 Phone 021 059 3140 – to arrive no later than September 5th 5pi DO NOT SEND DIRECT TO THE GALLERY.
- 11. **Receiving Day for Local Artists:** Delivery to the Aigantighe Art Gallery, Wai-iti Road, Timaru between 9:30am and 2pm on Tuesday 16th September. No late entries can be accepted.
- 12. Commission on work sold is 25% of the sale price.
- 13. Collection of sold / unsold work is the responsibility of the purchaser / artist. Work MUST be collected from the Gallery Sunday October 12th. SOLD work may be collected from 3.30pm. UNSOLD work from 4pm
- 14. IF ANY ARTIST HAS WON FIRST PRIZE IN A CATEGORY IN THE PREVIOUS <u>TWO</u> ANNUAL EXHIBITIONS, THEY WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE FOR FIRST PRIZE.
