Terms & Conditions of Entry

Entries open 28th August 2026.

Entries Close 11th September at 5pm

- 1: Entry is open to current financial members of any recognised NZ art society
 - 2: All work must be for sale, original and the sole work of the exhibitor. Not copied and not done in a class of instruction.
 - 2a: Photographic works are not eligible and will not be accepted.
 - 3: Works must not have been exhibited in a show previously and must have been completed in the previous 12 months. Works must not breach any copyright laws.
 - 4: Artists agree to all artwork becoming available for SCAS to use in advertising or promotional activities, now and in the future.
 - 5: Entry fee is \$20 per artwork, a maximum of 3 entries per artist.
Entry fee is non-refundable.
 - 6: While every care is taken, SCAS or its Members, accepts no liability for any loss or damage All
 - 7: Insurance in transit and in situ at the gallery will be the sole responsibility of the artist.
 - 8: Digital images of all entries must be forwarded via the online entry form
 - 9: String is not needed, as the gallery uses D rings to attach to the wall. Please ensure D rings are pointing upward – this is a request from gallery. No D rings - no entry
 - 10: 2D works must be suitably mounted for exhibition. Maximum 1.2m x 1.2m including frame. NO wet work accepted.
- Each artwork must be clearly identified on the back with the name of the artist, title, medium and price.

11: All work is subject to selection – the decision of the selection panel is final, and no correspondence will be entered into. Artists will be notified where works have not been selected.

11. Receiving Day for Local Artists: Delivery to the Aigantighe Art Gallery, Wai-iti Road, Timaru

between 9:30am and 2pm on Tuesday 12th October. No late entries can be accepted.

12. Commission on work sold is 25% of the sale price.

13. Collection of sold / unsold work is the responsibility of the purchaser / artist. Work MUST be collected from the Gallery Sunday 15th November.

SOLD work may be collected from 3.30pm.

UNSOLD work from 4pm

14. IF ANY ARTIST HAS WON FIRST PRIZE IN A CATEGORY IN THE PREVIOUS TWO ANNUAL EXHIBITIONS, THEY WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE FOR FIRST PRIZE IN THAT CATEGORY.

15: EMERGING ARTIST AWARD

This is defined as an artist under the age of 25 years, or and artist of any age who has exhibited for no more than 5 years (or less)
